Dear Secretary and Council:

In response to a request for review of a Default Arbitration Provider contract, for three reasons, I consider the contract commercially reasonable. First, it is possible to contract around the default arbitrator. Second, the reputation of Próspera Arbitration Center, LLC is intimately bound with Próspera ZEDE; if the former's reputation is soiled, so is that of the latter, so there is an incentive to maintain an impeccable reputation in order to keep Próspera ZEDE a desirable place to do business. And third, the founding judges do have excellent credentials.
